He also serves as the Vice-President of YABIAD, a foreign investor association focused on forging and promoting links with Turkey's business community.

Mr Ibragimov is closely involved in a number of charitable initiatives and roles including as the Chair Trustee of "I am part of", a UK charity focused on providing access to water and hunger relief to people in Africa and Asia. He is also Chairman of the Asian World Film Festival and has supported a wide range of cultural projects across different countries.

Mr Ibragimov is a graduate of the European Business School London and the Beijing Language and Culture University. He is fluent in English, Russian, French and Turkish, and has a working knowledge of Mandarin.

ERG is the world's largest high-carbon ferrochrome producer by chrome content and among the principal copper and cobalt suppliers. It is also one of the largest suppliers of alumina and iron ore in Eurasia and the only producer of high-grade aluminium in the Republic of Kazakhstan.

In Kazakhstan, ERG represents one third of the metals and mining industry. It is also a key power supplier and a large railway operator in Central Asia.
